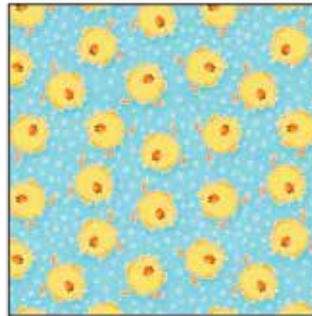

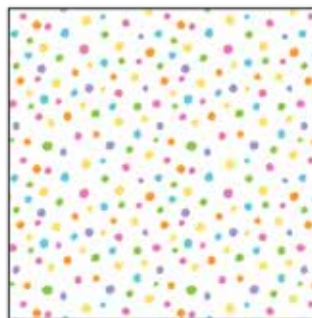

½ yard	Patch - Multi (A)	6679-21
⅓ yard	Dot - Pink (B)	6684-22
⅓ yard	Dot - Multi (C)	6684-21
⅓ yard	Easter Eggs - Purple (D)	6681-55
¼ yard	Chicks - Pink (E)	6680-22
¼ yard	Chicks - Turq. (F)	6680-11
⅝ yard	Bunnies and Baskets - Turq. (G)	6682-11
¼ yard	Folio - Lime Green (H)	7755-69
⅓ yard	Folio - Butter (I)	7755-03
½ yard	Folio - Violet (J)	7755-56*
⅛ yard	Folio - Peony Pink (K)	7755-52
2 ½ yards	Easter Eggs - Multi (Backing)	6681-21

*Includes binding

Quilt Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Patch - Multi (A), fussy cut:

- (1) 12 ½" x 16 ½" strip.

From the Dot - Pink (B), cut:

- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) 1 ½" x 16 ½" strips.
- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) 1 ½" x 14 ½" strips.
- See instructions to cut (3) eggs.

From the Dot - Multi (C), cut:

- (2) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (12) 4 ½" squares.

From the Easter Eggs - Purple (D), cut:

- (2) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (10) 4 ½" squares.

From the Chicks - Pink (E), cut:

- See instructions to cut (3) eggs.

From the Chicks - Turq. (F), cut:

- See instructions to cut (6) eggs.

From the Bunnies and Baskets - Turq. (G), cut:

- (2) 4 ½" x 31 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 4 ½" x 35 ½" WOF strips.

From the Folio - Lime Green (H), cut:

- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) 1 ½" x 18 ½" strips.
- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) 1 ½" x 16 ½" strips.
- See instructions to cut (3) bands.

From the Folio - Butter (I), cut:

- (2) 2" x 28 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 27 ½" WOF strips.
- See instructions to cut (3) bands.

From the Folio - Violet (J), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.
- See instructions to cut (3) bands.

From the Folio - Peony Pink (K), cut:

- See instructions to cut (3) bands.

From the Easter Eggs - Multi (Backing), cut:

- (2) 43" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 43" x 47" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about $\frac{1}{8}$ " outside the drawn lines.
2. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
3. Refer to the quilt photo to arrange and press (1) Fabric E egg and (1) Fabric H band onto (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square.
4. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Block One (Fig. 1).
5. Repeat Steps 3-4 to make (3) Block Ones total.
6. Repeat Steps 3-4 using (3) Fabric F eggs, (3) Fabric I bands and (3) Fabric C squares to make (3) Block Twos (Fig. 2).

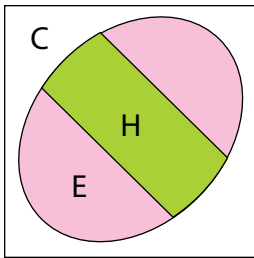

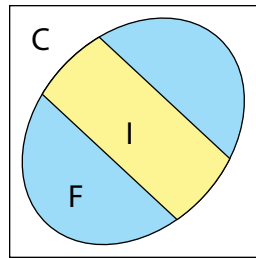

7. Repeat Steps 3-4 using (3) Fabric B eggs, (3) Fabric J bands and (3) Fabric C squares to make (3) Block Threes (Fig. 3).
8. Repeat Steps 3-4 using (3) Fabric F eggs, (3) Fabric K bands and (3) Fabric C squares to make (3) Block Fours (Fig. 4).

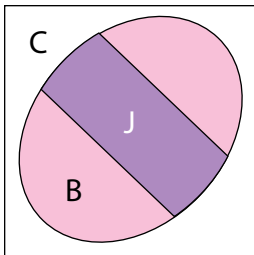

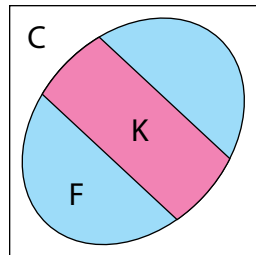

9. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strip. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A strip to make the Center Block.

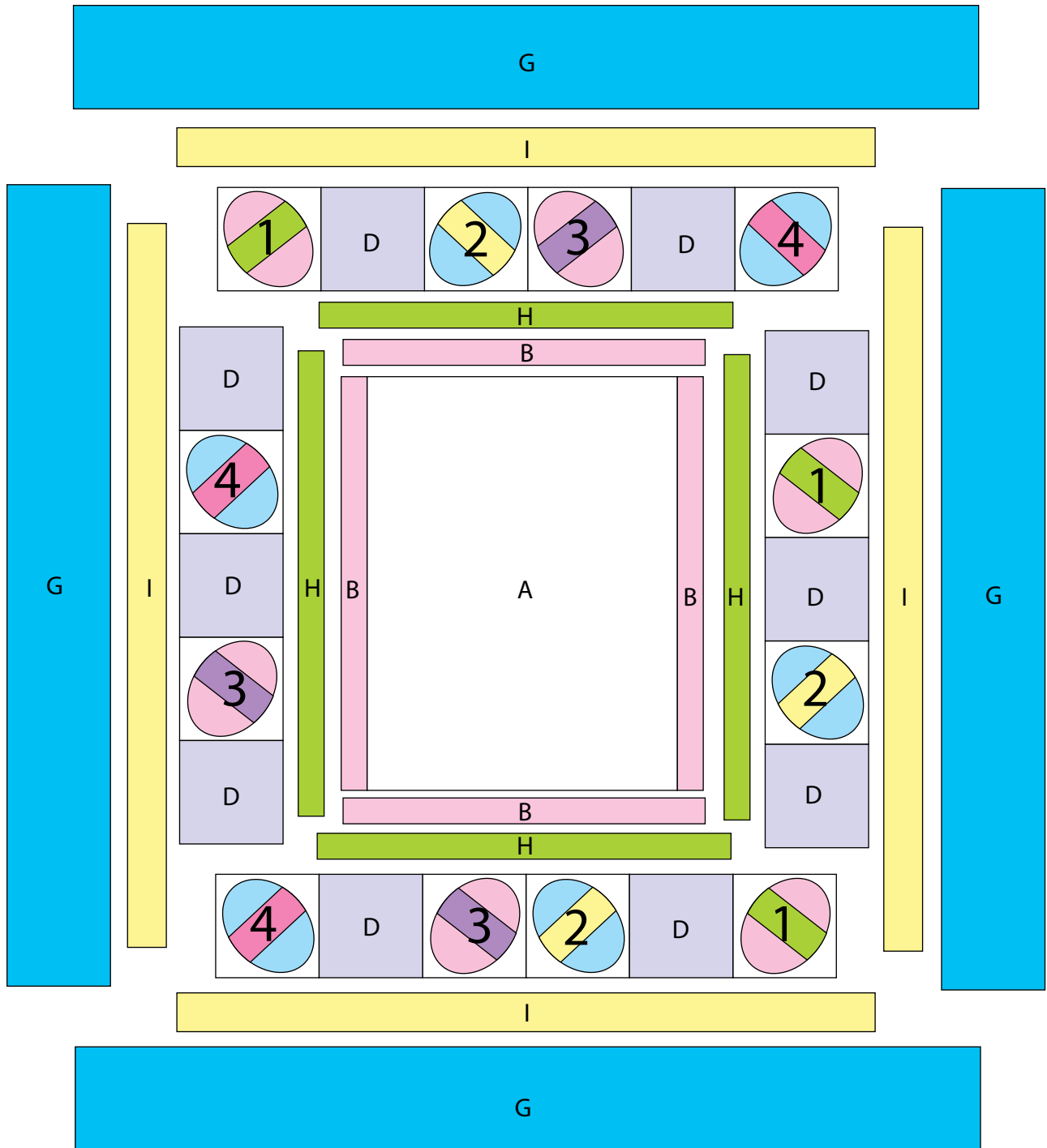
Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the *Quilt Layout while assembling.*)

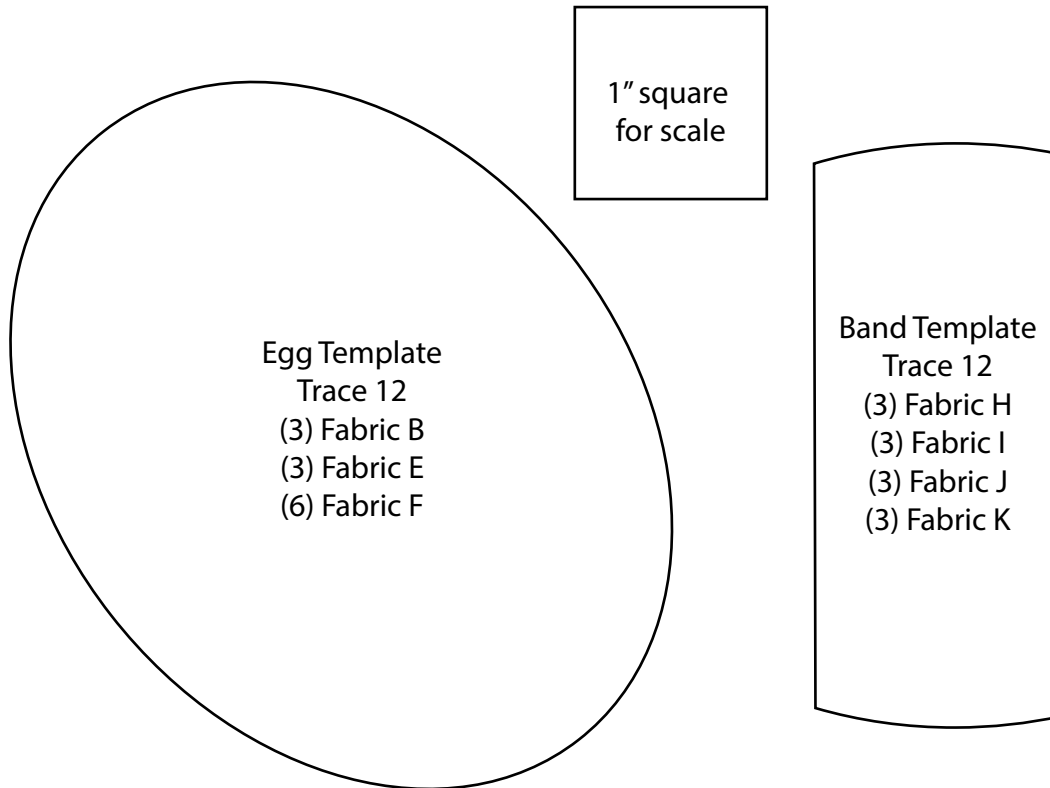
10. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $18\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew (3) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D squares and (2) assorted blocks together, alternating them, to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the Center Block.
12. Sew (4) assorted blocks and (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D squares together. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
13. Sew (1) 2 " x $28\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 " x $27\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
14. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $31\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $35\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
15. Layer and quilt as desired.
16. Sew the (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric J strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
17. Bind as desired.
